Humberto Cardoso, the founder of Quinta do Piloto, had an ancient knowledge making this type of fortified wines, revealed in each bottle. This knowledge has passed generation to generation.

The blend between the vineyards planted in the mountain in clay soils to give freshness with the vineyards planted in the plain with sandy soils to give sweetness are one of those knowlage.

Quinta do Piloto is state located in Palmela region from Cardoso family. Cardoso family is one of the ancient Palmela families with great traditions in making the best and traditionalist Palmela wines. Humberto Cardoso was the creator of Quinta do Piloto, now Filipe Cardoso is the 4th generation of the family
