DOC _ Regional Alentejano

Varieties _ 100% Castelão

Harvest _ Hand-picked to 20Kg boxes and carefully selected at the cellar.

Vinification _ Stainless steel tanks with controlled temperature, and low extraction.

Ageing _ 12 months in used French oak barrels.

Bottling _ March 2021

Production _ 3.559 bottles

Alcohol _ 13 pH _ 3.37 Total acidity _ 5.7

Tasting note _ Cherry red color. Intense red fruits aromas, predominantly cherry. The oak is perfectly integrated in its aroma and flavor. Very soft on the tannins, equilibrated, elegant, fresh and structured, with a long and delicious finish.
