Red Alentejo Regional Wine

This wine is the result of my incessant search for very old vines in Serra de São Mamede, 700 meters above sea level. I have been recovering them over the years. It was aged for 24 months in used French oak barrels brought from Burgundy, to preserve the vineyard's identity.

VARIETIES

Mixture of 2 vineyards, one of traditional grape varieties from Serra de São Mamede and other of Alicante Bouchet, dryland and very low production.

HARVEST

By hand in 20 Kg boxes with a rigorous selection before entering the winery.

TASTING NOTE

Very dark red color, almost black. The notes of ripe and intense fruit, although without any excess maturation, with tobacco notes and a mineral background appear accompanied by a vegetable suggestion that adds an unusual complexity and tension. Lively and powerful, austere but delicate it surprises with its lively but serene tannins, finishing fresh and vigorous.
