Description

Vinha dos Pardais White is a wine made from grapes grown in a small vineyard known for attracting flocks of sparrows searching for the sweetest grapes in the region. This vineyard is located at Herdade da Agualva and has belonged to the Cardoso family since the time of the founder, Humberto Cardoso. The wine is produced from Sauvignon Blanc and Fernão Pires grapes, expressing freshness, aromatic intensity and Atlantic terroir character.

History

Quinta do Piloto is located in Serra do Louro, in the Palmela region, and belongs to the Cardoso family, one of the oldest families in the region, with a strong connection to winemaking since the early 20th century. Founded by Humberto Cardoso, the estate is currently led by the 4th generation.

Fermentation: Stainless steel tanks with controlled temperature

Colour: Pale yellow with greenish highlights

Aroma: Tropical notes combined with a slight vegetal character, recalling green asparagus

Palate: Vibrant and fresh acidity, with mineral and light vegetal notes, reflecting Atlantic terroir characteristics
