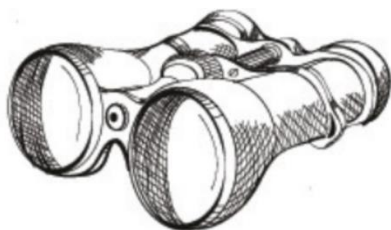

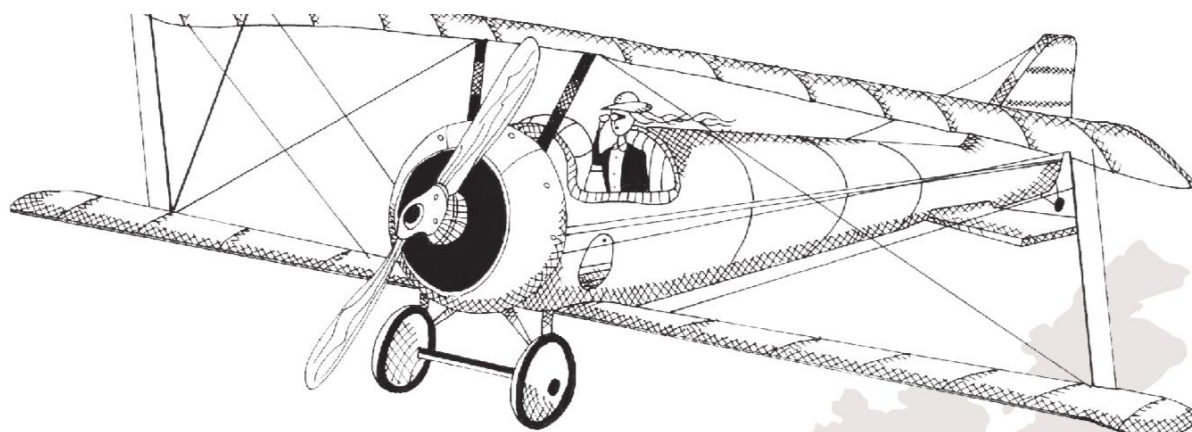
_ 80% Stainless Steel tanks with temperature control / 20% 1200L seasoned Alsatian fuder
