

VINHA Barrosa 2016

PHILOSOPHY

Baga is a Portuguese indigenous grape variety perfectly adapted to the soils and climate of the Bairrada region. To better display the character of the region, this wine is made from a single vineyard called Vinha Barrosa. This vineyard, planted in a traditional method before 1932, is surrounded by a pine forest where there are also some eucalyptuses that add a special fragrance to the wine.
